Thank you for your interest in volunteering with Engineers without Borders (EWB). Our work would not be possible without your support.

In 2005 alone, about 350 volunteers participated in EWB-USA projects, of which 250 were students. Their work improved the life of 45,000 people around the world.

  - EWB mailbox in NEB 126 (*Check Only*)

## FAQ

***Q: How long do my EWB-USA and EWB-JHU memberships last?***

**A:** Both your EWB-USA and EWB-JHU memberships are valid for one academic year.

***Q: I registered for EWB in the Spring, do I have to re-register in the Fall?***

**A:** Yes, you must reregister. If you became a member in the Spring 2006, you will need to re-register during the following school year to remain a member. The new membership will be valid for one academic year.

***Q: Where do I return my membership form?***

**A:** Please return your membership form to any of the following: Project Leader, EWB-JHU Treasurer, EWB mailbox in NEB 126.

***Q: If I'm not sure if I will be able to travel with my project team, should I still register?***

**A:** Yes, it is highly recommended that you register. Registration helps defray the cost of Chapter Membership (\$300 per chapter per year) and demonstrates your commitment to sustainable development through Engineers without Borders.
